Alliance Theater – Virtual Education Internship

In this virtual summer camp through the Alliance Theater, I will be working in online classroom spaces with Alliance Theatre Teaching Artists to assist in classroom tasks and putting on a virtual performance at the end of every camp week. Throughout my weeks working with Alliance, I hope to gain skills in classroom management, directorial techniques, acting techniques, theatre games, conflict resolution and virtual teaching techniques.
